PART I – NON-CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

030/11 Public Speaking – (Fifteen Minutes)

Mr Ian Bradder of Lings Crescent informed the Council that his drive way had been unusable since the road had been resurfaced.

Force Projects / Divisional Projects

A force wide campaign has been running since December 1st under the banner of Operation IMPACT - this is an 8 week operation to tackle Violence and Domestic Abuse. Also targeted in this operation will be alcohol related violence whether in the home or on the streets.

Local Safer Neighbourhood Matters

Priority Profiles on **South Eastern SNT** are

1. Anti-Social Behaviour around the Shops area of Pilsley
2. Anti-Social Behaviour around North Side Area, Tupton.
3. Speeding Vehicles around Stonebroom and Shirland.

A number of metal thefts have taken place in the village over the last few weeks – The infant / Nursery school was targeted where offenders were disturbed attempting to remove lead from a window area. A pair of jogging bottoms were recovered at the scene as the offender fled. Following this an attempt was made to get lead from a residential property on THE GREEN.

Residents have reported a number of suspicious vehicles in the area which are believed to be engaging in metal recycling. This follows a number of incidents where metal items have been removed from gardens without permission. Such vehicles are always checked out when encountered and some travel far afield to collect waste legitimately. The drivers of these vehicles must hold a waste carrier licence and the relevant business insurance to convey scrap.

A number of Section 59 Notices have been placed around North Wingfield to inform bike users of the legalities of riding machines on public areas. Signage has gone up along the Five Pits Trail, King Georges Field, Deincourt Field and Perry Bar Areas. Now the signs are in place we have the power to confiscate bikes at first opportunity as signage acts as a First Warning.

Reports of a nuisance motor bikes have been minimal with one reported incident arising around KING GEORGES PLAYING FIELDS area. A Bike was stopped and the rider issued with a First Section 59 Warning.

North Wingfield kids have been involved in a number of activities through the half term holidays with Oz-Box Sessions taking place and also Golf Sessions on Grassmoor Driving Range. Both were well attended.

A small number of incidents involving missing wheelie bins have been reported. These seem to be around the Hephthorne Lane area.

I am continuing to attend regular Community Surgeries where local residents can meet me to discuss any issues. No appointments needed on a 'drop in' basis. A list of these surgeries is available on the police website – www.derbyshire.police.uk
