More bad weather experienced in the region and no major incidents to report on our roads or in Snow- balling incidents have been at a minimum with only two incidents reported through December and none of these incidents have caused any damage or injury.

No movement at the ELMS, BRIGHT STREET since it was announced that the site has been sold to a local developer. This area has continued to be monitored while on patrol – although there are signs that residents are still using this as ‘cut-through’ and a few bottles and litter has been left around the ‘garaged’ area indicating some use by local residents no calls for service have been received for several months.

No Reports or sightings of nuisance motor cycles have been received in December –will continue to be vigilant and gather intelligence to identify bikes previously reported including a white and green bike with no VRM plate originating from the ALMA Estate area.

Mayflower Traveller Site off DARK LANE remains unoccupied. A number of calls had been made by residents who have expressed concern for the welfare of 3 horses at the rear of the traveller’s site. These horses have now been removed by the RSPCA to a sanctuary in Leicester.

The Christmas and New Years Events seemingly passed relatively peacefully - disturbances in the Miners Welfare on Boxing Day and New Years Eve were attended by Police and quickly resolved.

The cold weather brought a number of problems with a large volume of reports dealing with abandoned vehicles – left in the snow. Also the Police have attended a number of addresses where entry has needed to be forced following burst pipes and damage to property.

I am continuing to attend regular Community Surgeries where local residents can meet me to discuss any issues. No appointments needed on a 'drop in' basis. A list of these surgeries is available on the police website – www.derbyshire.police.uk
