Reducing our Carbon Footprint

Photovoltaic Solar Panels have now been installed on the roof of the Parish Council's new garage on Whiteleas Avenue.

These panels will provide electricity for the garage and any excess generated will be sold back to the National Grid.

50% of the cost was provided by a grant from the BRE Low Carbon Buildings Programme.

The 'sell back' price of electricity is currently set at 41.3p per KW hour, at this rate it has been estimated that the system will pay for its self within 5 1/2 years.

The carbon saved will be in the region of 1.5 tonnes per year.

The system was installed by the Chesterfield based firm EcoSkies who also assisted in the grant application.



We are now hoping to secure funding to allow us to install a similar system in the Community Resource Centre.

We have also secured a grant to install solar panels onto the new building which will not only demonstrate that we are community leaders but could help generate some income.

We have continued to maintain the village to a high standard and the new benches and litter bins have been appreciated.

We have continued to support community groups within the village and organised a presentation evening which was a big success helping bring together these various community groups to meet one another.

There have been one or two issues around the village but I believe by working with Andy Newton, the PCSO, and Amanda Boulter, the Neighbourhood Champion, we are keeping North Wingfield a pleasant and safe place to live.
