## Hepthorne Lane Community Centre

The Hepthorne Lane Community Association continues to make improvements to the Hepthorne Lane Community Centre (previously known as the Evergreen Club). There have been significant improvements to the toilet and kitchen areas over the last 6 months and a new central heating system is due to be installed before October.

There is now a regular programme of activities including Small Wonders toddler group on Thursday mornings, Zumba classes on Tuesday evenings, a Craft group on Friday mornings, the Methodist Church hold services on Sundays and the Evergreen Club continue to meet every Monday evening and Tuesday afternoon.

## Walking for Health

### Walking can help improve your health and wellbeing

North East Derbyshire District Council set up 'Walking for Health' last year and in North Wingfield this has proved very popular. The walks are suitable for all levels of ability and are led by trained volunteers.

Walks take place every Tuesday, come rain or shine, and start from the North Wingfield Community Resource Centre on Whiteleas Avenue.

The group meet at 10.30am for a pre-walk cup of coffee and set off walking at 11am for approximately 1 hour (2 miles). Bacon cobs are often available when the walkers return to the Resource Centre.

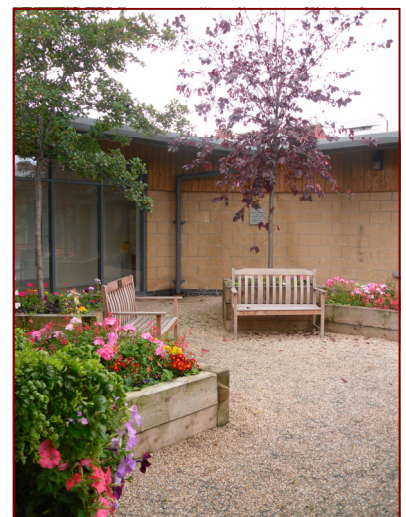

## Community Resource Centre

It is now over 5 years since the new Community Resource Centre on Whiteleas Avenue opened. During that time the building has proved very successful and still manages to be self funding which is rare for a Community Centre in the current economic climate.

The Centre can be booked for private parties for which we have a large function room, a fully licensed bar, a kitchen and we can help with catering and entertainment. Our beautiful courtyard is the perfect place for family photos and we have hosted many weddings and christenings.

We were delighted to be able to install a second PV solar system on the roof of the Community Centre in June and it has already generated over 900kwh of electricity which equates to over £400 in Feed-in-Tariff.



## An up-date from Rykneld Homes

### Our plans for North Wingfield homes

#### Decent Homes

Early next year, as part of the Decent Homes programme, Rykneld Homes will be replacing all external doors on Council properties in North Wingfield where they have not already had new composite ones fitted.

The work is scheduled to take place in February and tenants will be given a choice on door colour.

Further Decent Homes work is also scheduled to be carried out in North Wingfield between 2013/15. Once we have finalised our capital programme for these years we will be consulting with tenants in the area.

#### Community Investment

Rykneld Homes and its partners are also working with the Council to take forward their Shaping the Future programme in North Wingfield. Through our Community Investment Plan we will be working with tenants and residents to make sure our resources are directed to where they are most needed.

Rykneld and its partners is also looking to use a local venue, such as the Community Resource Centre, to act as a focal point where people can access or find out about different services. We will be consulting with tenants and residents on this and would welcome your suggestions.

Please look out for our programme of estate walkabouts which will be held this autumn. Tenants and residents are welcome to attend – dates are included in our Homing In magazine, on our website and in our Area Housing Offices.
